

Coordinated Campaign Regional Field Director

The Delaware Democratic Party is hiring four Regional Field Directors for its 2018 Coordinated Campaign. These positions will report directly to Delaware's Statewide Field Director, and will play an important role in helping to execute the 2018 Coordinated Campaign's field plan by helping to oversee field staff and volunteers.

Delaware's electoral outlook includes U.S. Senate and U.S. House races atop the ticket, along with an open Attorney General's seat and the opportunity to flip the State Auditor and State Treasurer seats from red to blue. We also have majorities to defend and grow in both houses of our General Assembly.

The preferred candidate will have the soft skills to complement his/her field acumen, and will have experience working collaboratively with a diverse group of stakeholders, organizers and volunteers.

Responsibilities will include:

- Helping develop and oversee completion of voter contact and volunteer recruitment goals
- Training and deploying field organizers within the region while defining goals and measuring progress
- Maintaining key political relationships within the region
- Working closely with the statewide and local races on the ground
- Reporting to the Coordinated Campaign Field Director
- Preparing weekly reports for Statewide Field Director
- Helping to facilitate communications with field staff
- Assisting with site location for regional field offices

Required Skills and Experience:

- At least one cycle of political organizing experience required – staff management experience preferred
- The know-how to get best results from staff and volunteers
- Familiarity with VoteBuilder
- Strong organizational skills
- Willingness to work long hours and weekends
- Must have a car, as extensive travel is required
